● CONDITIONS OF FOREIGN STUDENTS MOVING INTO THE DORM

- As a rule, the contractor will be the guardian of the student moving into the dorm. If the guardian lives outside of Japan, consult us about it beforehand.
- The student should be able to carry on a simple conversation in Japanese.
- At the time of concluding a contract, a joint guarantor has to be designated. A person qualified for a joint surety is the student's relative living in Japan or the school she goes to. If the student cannot designate a joint surety, either of the following methods should be employed.
 - Lump sum payment of annual room charges and administrative expenses
 - Use of guarantor service to be provided by a guarantor agency to be designated by us (the amount of the service fee is about 50% of the monthly room charge)

1. Please fill in the required items on this application form and submit it together with an application fee of 50,000 yen.
2. Please attend a student and guardian interview after application. Please contact us if due to circumstances it is difficult for the guardian and/or student to attend. At the interview, we will explain the dormitory rules and provide you with documents for entering the dormitory, such as the contract and detailed charges.
3. Please pay the total amount needed at the time of entry to the dormitory by bank transfer within two weeks of attending the interview. We will contact you as soon as the date of entry to the dormitory is decided.

For persons resident overseas

1. Please fill in the required items on this application form and send it to us as an email attachment.
2. Please pay an application fee of 50,000 yen by bank transfer.
3. We will send you documents for entering the dormitory, such as the contract and detailed charges, etc. by email. Please pay the total amount needed at the time of entry to the dormitory by bank transfer within two weeks and inform us of the date of your flight to Japan and the date of entry to the dormitory.
4. Upon your arrival, we will provide you with the key, give you an orientation and explain the rules of the dormitory. Please submit the contract and any other necessary documents at this time. *Check-in is available from 9:00 to 17:00. If you arrive after 17:00, you will be required to enter the dormitory after 9:00 the following day.
